Weathering (and communicating) the storm

Many Rhode Islanders remain without electricity and telephone service at their homes while the affects of Tropical Storm Irene are dealt with.

The impact on the installation was minimal compared to what could have been if the storm hit our region with stronger force. This good fortune provides an excellent opportunity to look closely at how personnel prepared for this storm – both at work and at home.

Additionally, it allows Public Affairs the opportunity to clarify some items that probably will come up again living here in New England.

Are you "Essential?" This term is used to get a concise message out using the R.I. Broadcasters Association regarding who should report to work. In general, if you see the Naval Station (NAVSTA) Newport status indicating: The Base is Open for Essen-

tial Personnel Only, you can assume that operations are significantly reduced. Morale, Welfare and Recreation Department operations, the Newport Commissary and Navy Exchange facilities will not be open.

Personnel assigned to any of the commands onboard NAVSTA should understand before any weather event if they should report to work. Know beforehand by talking to your own chain of command what you should do.

Communication – Keeping NAVSTA and tenant command personnel updated on the status of the installation through social media during a storm can be a challenge. For many individuals who were without power and did not have a battery operated Internet capable wireless device, posting status notifications, and broadcasting them, was not really helpful.

NAVSTA hosts USCG training

380 personnel from 29 cutters here for a week

A fleet of 16 cutters from U.S. Coast Guard District One departed Naval Station (NAVSTA) Newport's Pier 2 last week following the conclusion of the district's 2011 Operations, Training and Readiness conference.

The cutters arrived Aug. 21 for classroom training and conferences using facilities at the Officers' Club, Callaghan Hall, the Lt. Michael P. Murphy Combat Training Pool, Port Operations and Pier 2. A total of 380 Coast Guard personnel representing 29 cutters assigned to the district's area of operation attended the training.

"Naval Station Newport is central to our First District AOR (area of operations)," said Rear Adm. Dan Neptun, commander, Coast Guard District One, Boston. In his conference opening remarks, Neptun told district personnel to always consider risk management, to work together as a team, and to prepare for the out-years that could be fiscally challenging.

"Holding this conference at Naval Station Newport allows us to use a resource where we can train hundreds of personnel at one time," he said.

Classroom training included Aids to Navigation (ATON), leadership and management, nautical rules of the road, the vessel opportunity oil skimming system, and air conditioning and refrigeration.







one, however, who could not find a way to keep a cell phone charged (spare batteries, charging via their vehicles). As we continue into hurricane season, which will quickly be followed up by the New England winter storm season, ask someone far away who you may notify to assure them of your well-being to become a fan of the Naval Station Newport Rhode Island Facebook site and make note of one of the many pages we will use to broadcast the base status. Save the base condition line on your cell phone (401) 841-2211 and call it for periodic updates. Make sure you have the telephone numbers for your co-workers or supervisors.

Accountability: The Navy Family Accountability and Assessment System (NFAAS) is a standard method for the Navy to account, manage and monitor the recovery process for personnel and their families affected and/or scattered by a wide-spread event. The NFAAS provides valuable information to all levels of the Navy chain of command allowing commanders to make strategic decisions. Each tenant command has an NFAAS point of contact.

If you cannot access the NFAAS website (<https://navyfamily.navy.mil>) after a storm or extreme event, call your chain of command contact and report your status and your family's status. Make sure you know the telephone number you should call to muster. Make sure to go into NFAAS and verify your command is accurate if you are a recent arrival to NAVSTA.
