

Gilbert Street Closure: 2-11 April

Gilbert Street will be closed to thru traffic from 6 p.m., April 2 until 6 p.m., April 11 to upgrade central steam lines. The specific closure location will be from the intersection at Farragut Street to the N-24 (Gym) pedestrian crosswalk. Recommended access to the air side of the base (east of Bainbridge Ave/Gate 3A) is via Gates 4, 10 or 22 on Granby Street and/or Ridgewell Ave. Access to the water side of the base (west of Bainbridge Ave./Gate 3A) is via Gates 1, 2, 5 or 6 on Hampton Blvd. and/or Admiral Taussig Blvd. Detour route will be Maryland or Bainbridge Avenues to Massey Hughes Drive.
