

## myPay Changes Enhance Ease of Use

myPay enhancements are designed to make the site easier and more convenient for DFAS customers. myPay allows many of the six million payroll customers of DFAS to access pay information, retrieve tax forms, and update such items as direct deposit account numbers, allotments and tax withholding amounts. The new upgrade will reduce the number of steps required to login to myPay and make the virtual keyboard an unusual security feature designed to protect usernames and passwords optional. Users will simply enter their Login ID and password on the home page and click once to accept the user agreement for access to their accounts. Security features include encryption to protect sensitive information, firewalls, and intrusion detection software to block outsiders from accessing accounts. The upgrade is the first of a series of enhancements myPay is planning to make this year. Beginning in mid to late May, users will be able to access Leave and Earning Statements using mobile devices, such as smart phones, enabled with web browsers.

## Texting Dangers

Texting while walking or driving is increasingly recognized as hazardous. Many states, including Virginia, prohibit texting while driving. When you are driving or walking focus on the path of travel. While in transit, turn your phone off, or at least put it on silent. Cutting yourself off from the "beep" of temptation could be all it takes.
