NAVY'S INSPECTION OF HOMES CONTINUES

Norfolk, Va. – The Navy's contractor, Marine Chemist Services out of Newport News VA, continues to inspect approximately 14 Lincoln Military homes. At least nine of the homes previously had inspections completed by Lincoln Military Housing (LMH) contractor Apex.

The inspections began Wednesday, Dec. 14 and will continue until all inspections are completed. As of today, seven inspections have been completed and 10 have been scheduled. Maintenance Task Force has visited 610 houses generating 184 mold inspection requests. Work at the homes will include mold inspections in the form of visual examinations with additional testing, including air sampling and tape samplings, as required.

Inspection results are expected within five business days of the completed inspection. No results have been received on the completed inspections, but the Navy expects to receive the results this week. Upon receipt families will sit down with Navy representatives to review results upon receipt in order to answer any questions and discuss further action should it be needed.

Last night, the Navy hosted the third and final housing forum at LMH Community Center in Yorktown, Va. The forums provided residents the opportunity to learn what Navy resources are available to support them, how to locate appropriate rental housing and how to resolve landlord/tenant problems. Approximately 14 families attended last night's forum.
