NAVY CONTRACTOR COMPLETES HOME INSPECTIONS

Norfolk, Va. – The Navy contractor hired last month to conduct independent mold inspections for 14 Lincoln Military Housing (LMH) homes has completed the work. Marine Chemist, Inc., out of Newport News, was contracted to do mold inspections in the form of visual examinations with additional testing as required.

After receiving the results, Navy Housing, Navy Marine Corps Public Health and LMH representatives met individually with several families to review their results and answer any questions they had.

Last month a joint Navy and LMH Maintenance Task Force was established to conduct maintenance inspections of all LMH homes in Hampton Roads. These inspections will include visual examinations for mold with additional testing. The Task Force teams have visited 1,657 homes to date.

A total of 436 of the 4,300 units managed by Lincoln have been identified for mold inspections. To date, 193 of the 436 mold inspections have been completed by LMH's contracted companies.
