VIRGINIA BEACH, VA...Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek (JEBLCFS) will host The Warrior Ride's adaptive cycling event for combat wounded military personnel, April 26, at 9:30 a.m.

More than 25 riders are scheduled to participate in this years event that will have participants riding a course across JEBLCFS and on to Naval Station Norfolk.

"The Warrior Ride", a non-profit organization, is conducting this adaptive cycling event to provide a bicycling experience for combat wounded service members. The first goal of the event is to provide recreation and rehabilitation to the riders.
