

Unaccompanied Housing

UH is designed to house personnel permanently assigned to Naval Station Norfolk or any of the resident commands. Unaccompanied Housing is not designed or authorized to house personnel under "No Cost" TAD orders.

Midshipmen Summer Training

Commencing 5 July, [NSN Navy Gateway Inns and Suites](#) and ships will host hundreds of NROTC midshipmen over the summer. These young and impressionable service members will be interacting with us in the Galley, in MWR facilities, in barracks, in our work spaces, and on liberty. The midshipmen are regularly briefed on Fleet policies, especially pertaining to personal behavior, under-age drinking, alcohol incidents, and fraternization. Now is the PERFECT time to have a similar discussion with your Sailors to ensure they understand that midshipman shall not fraternize with Enlisted Sailors.

Transient Personnel Unit

The volume of separations is consistently larger in the summer due to a majority of personnel entering the Navy (and therefore separating or retiring) during this timeframe.

To help mitigate backlogs and facilitate a manageable workload throughout this peak processing period, TPU Norfolk should be contacted approximately 30 days prior to the member's arrival so TPU Norfolk can schedule and coordinate appointments in advance.

TPU Norfolk normally requests separating and retiring Sailors to arrive 8-10 days prior to when the member intends to begin terminal leave; however, if advance notification is not possible, please send the Sailor to TPU Norfolk at least 15 days prior to the Sailor's intended terminal leave/PDTY date to ensure adequate separation processing time at PSD.
