2. THE NAVY CONTINUES TO SUCCESSFULLY DEPLOY AND EMPLOY ITS IA SAILORS

IN SUPPORT OF THE GLOBAL WAR ON TERROR (GWOT). REF A ANNOUNCED THE

ASSIGNMENT OF USFF AS EXECUTIVE AGENT (EA) AND SUPPORTED COMMANDER FOR

IA AND IA FAMILY SUPPORT ACROSS THE IA CONTINUUM. THIS IS IN ADDITION

TO USFF'S ASSIGNED RESPONSIBILITIES AS THE GLOBAL FORCE MANAGER FOR

IA'S. USFF WILL EXECUTE THIS RESPONSIBILITY BY:

A. INTEGRATING STAKEHOLDER INITIATIVES INTO A SYNCHRONIZED IA

CONTINUUM OF CARE AND SUPPORT, B. DEVELOPING, WITH STAKEHOLDERS,

SOLUTIONS TO EMERGING IA CONTINUUM OF CARE AND SUPPORT ISSUES, AND C.

DECONFLICTING IA SOURCING PROCESSES WITH IA AND IA FAMILY CARE AND SUPPORT SERVICE EXECUTION.

3. USFF WILL EMPLOY A CROSS FUNCTIONAL TEAM (CFT) OF STAKEHOLDERS FROM ACROSS THE NAVY AND THE NAVY PREPAREDNESS ALLIANCE (NPA) TO DEVELOP PROGRAM AND POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ECHELON I APPROVAL AND RESOURCING.

A. IA AND IA FAMILY SUPPORT CFT MEMBERS INCLUDE CNP, USFF, CNIC, BUMED AND CNR STAFF AND ARE WORKING ISSUES IN PREPARATION FOR TRANSITIONING IA AND IA FAMILY SUPPORT RESPONSIBILITIES FROM TFIA TO USFF. USFF AND TFIA WILL CO-HOST A TRANSITION CONFERENCE 25-26 AUGUST 2008 TO COMPLETE THE TURNOVER AND SUNSET TFIA. IA AND IA FAMILY SUPPORT CFT WILL MEET BI-WEEKLY FOLLOWING THE CONFERENCE.

B. NPA IS A DECISION MAKING BODY CONSISTING OF CNP, DEP USFF, CNR, SURGEON GENERAL, AND CNIC. THE NPA MEETS QUARTERLY TO ADDRESS NAVY SUPPORT PROGRAMS AND SERVICE DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS, RESOURCES, HEALTH, AND OVERALL PRODUCTIVITY.

C. USFF WILL COORDINATE ALL PROPOSED IA AND IA FAMILY SUPPORT INITIATIVES, BEST PRACTICES, AND LESSONS LEARNED THROUGH THE IA AND IA FAMILY SUPPORT CFT, AND THROUGH THE NPA AS REQUIRED. THE IA AND IA FAMILY SUPPORT CFT WILL PREPARE INITIATIVES FOR NPA DECISION, IDENTIFY RESOURCE REQUIREMENTS AND POTENTIAL SOURCING SOLUTIONS, AND PROMULGATE PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION GUIDANCE TO STAKEHOLDERS TO ENSURE CONSISTENT SUPPORT ACROSS THE NAVY. COMMANDERS CURRENTLY TASKED WITH DEVELOPING NEW IA AND IA FAMILY SUPPORT INITIATIVES OR POLICIES ARE REQUESTED TO PROVIDE THE SCOPE OF THEIR EFFORTS TO THE POCS IN PARA 5.A OR 5.E BY 1 OCT 08. USFF WILL WORK WITH ALL STAKEHOLDERS TO ENSURE THE MOST EFFECTIVE MEANS OF INCORPORATING THESE EFFORTS INTO THE IA CONTINUUM.

4. USFF WILL DIRECT EXECUTION OF IA AND IA FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAMS AND PROCESSES THROUGH STAKEHOLDER CHAINS OF COMMAND AS THE SUPPORTED COMMANDER SIMILAR TO USFF EXECUTION OF ITS RESPONSIBILITIES AS THE GLOBAL FORCE MANAGER FOR IAS. USFF AND THE APPROPRIATE STAKEHOLDER WILL OVERSEE EXECUTION PERFORMANCE OF IA CONTINUUM OF CARE PROGRAMS AND POLICIES TO ASSESS PROGRAM DELIVERY AND EFFECTIVENESS.
