New students and returning students with a break in enrollment of 2 semesters or more must submit an online application no later than 3 business days before the registration deadline by going to:

**IMPORTANT:** Enter the code **MIL1** on the Supplemental page of the online application which is your 4-digit program admission designator.

New Students receive notification of their MyCCC account upon acceptance of their application. This normally takes approximately 2-3 business days.

Students will receive an email containing information needed to access the Coastline Portal (MyCCC) and to proceed with registration.
