TOP 5 “Need to Know”

1. Our staff has made berthing and transportation arrangements for you. Do not make any berthing or travel arrangements on your own.
2. Call the NMPS Duty Driver (228-323-7074) prior to or immediately upon arrival at Gulfport International Airport.
3. POVs while assigned to NMPS Gulfport are not authorized unless prior authorization has been received by the OIC, SEA or via order modification from PERS or ECRC.
4. A Letter of Instruction (LOI) issued by the NMPS OIC or SEA will be provided upon arrival. This LOI will provide pertinent information for your stay while on board such as, next morning's muster time and location, what building to report to first, travel limitations and NMPS points of contact.
5. While assigned to NMPS Gulfport the travel restrictions for all personnel are as follows: With CBC being the center of the area, the east border is 13 miles to the east (Ocean Springs Bridge), the west border is 13 miles to the west (Bay St Louis Bridge) and the north border is not to exceed 5 miles north of Interstate 10 where it intersects with Hwy 49.

The time frames for redeployment and demobilization are dependent upon the following conditions:

- Day of arrival
- # of personnel currently being processed forward
- # of personnel currently being processed for redeployment/demobilization
- Availability of base support personnel/assets (i.e. medical, PSD, etc)
- Communication and visibility of incoming personnel to ensure adequate preparation prior to arrival
