

Executive Officers' Biography

Commander Scott Charles Gover

CDR Scott Gover was awarded a four year NROTC scholarship to attend Rochester Institute of Technology where he earned a Baccalaureate Degree in Mechanical Engineering; he received his commission from University of Rochester NROTC in 1988.

His first tour of duty was aboard USS CONCORD (AFS 5), where he served from 1990-1992 as Combat information Center Officer. In September 1992, CDR Gover reported to the USS Arleigh Burke (DDG 51) as the Damage Control Assistant.

In January 1994, CDR Gover attended Naval Postgraduate School Monterey where he earned a Master of Arts Degree in Foreign Affairs concentrating on Middle Eastern Studies. After Naval Postgraduate School he reported to USS Comte de Grasse (DD 974) as the Chief Engineer.

In July 1998, CDR Gover reported to COMDESRON TWENTY-TWO and served as the Materiel Officer. In November 2000, he attended Naval War College where he earned a Master of Arts Degree in Foreign Affairs. Following the Naval War College, CDR Gover served as Chief of Staff for COMPSRON One.

In June 2003, CDR Gover reported to MSCO NOREUR and served as Commanding Officer.

In September 2005, he reported to CCSG Nine and served as Materiel Officer.

Following his tour at CCSG Nine, CDR Gover deployed to Afghanistan on an Individual Assignment in support of the ISAF and served as Provincial Reconstruction Team (PRT) Chief in 2007.

CDR Gover currently serves as the Executive Officer at Afloat Training Group Mayport.

CDR Gover's awards include the Meritorious Service Medal, Navy Commendation Medal (6 awards), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (2 awards), and various unit and service awards.
