Reservation Policy

Reservations accepted daily from 1000-1600 hours. Reservations may be made in advance based on military or DoD status:

Water Craft Reservations:

Active Duty/Mil Retirees - 7 days

NSA DoD Civilians - 7 days

Other eligible patrons - 3 days

Recreation Lodging: (*Campers, Cabins, RV Sites*)

Active Duty/Mil Retirees - 90 days

NSA DoD Civilians - 90 days

Other eligible patrons - 60 days

Refund Policy

Watercraft reservations must be cancelled 24 hours in advance or the deposit will be forfeited.

Overnight accomodation reservations must be cancelled 48 hours in advance or you forfeit your deposit.

If an alternate date can not be scheduled for watercraft or overnight accomodations, an administrative fee of \$10 will be charged against the original balance. Full refunds will be given due to inclement weather.

Outdoor Recreation & Marina Office

The Outdoor Recreation Office handles reservations for boat rentals, camping, pavilion areas, and outdoor recreation programs. The shop rents camping gear and other outdoor equipment.

Marina

The Marina offers recreational boat storage of several types, wet slips, covered dry storage, and uncovered trailer storage. The Marina can provide last minute needs such as a variety of tackle, camping, and picnic items.

Cabins

Our comfortable log cabins have one bedroom, a sleeping loft and a futon to sleep six. Our cabins are equipped with a full bath, microwave, coffee maker, kitchen, serving and cooking utensils, AC/heat, and bed linens. We do not provide towels, so don't forget to bring your own. Pets are not allowed in our cabins. Our facilities are smoke free.

Travel Trailers

We have travel trailers with a bath; kitchen with stove, refrigerator, and microwave; AC and heat. We also have A-liner trailers with a kitchenette and no bathroom. Linens are not provided. Pets are not allowed in our trailers. Smoke free. Travel Trailers on site must check-in during normal business hours. Checkout/Pickup time is 1500. Check In/Return is 1200.

RV Parks

Mainside offers 20 RV campsites, 16 with full hookup (water, electric, cable and sewage), 4 with no sewer. **Southside** offers 24 spacious RV sites with full hookup complete with trash receptacles, an outdoor grill, and picnic table. All campers must check-in at the Mainside location prior to site assignment.



RV Park Check-In Procedures

Check-In

Check-In at the Outdoor Recreation and Marina Office located at the Marina on base during regular business hours.

After Hours Check-In

If you plan to arrive after our normal business hours, please call the reservation office the day of check-in by 1500 hours to inform our staff of your late arrival. You will be given instructions. The following day you must come to the Outdoor Recreation and Marina Office to complete the check-in process

Gate Information for Southside RV Park

Your key card will open the entry gate. It is only good for the scheduled/paid days of your visit. Your key card will automatically expire at noon the day of check-out. Please read over your contract and verify the dates.

Guests

All RV park guests are required to follow standard procedures for entering the base. Base visitors passes and decals are required.

Mainside RV Park Rules

Please use these guidelines to help keep our RV park a pleasant and relaxing place to vacation. Enjoy your stay with us and if you have any questions or concerns, please contact one of our staff members. Thank you!

1. RV's may not be left unoccupied for more than 96 hours.
2. RV units may not be subleased or released to another person; the individual renting the site must occupy the RV.
3. Tent camping is not allowed.
4. External structures of any kind cannot be erected on a site.
5. Appliances, other than those designed in the RV, are prohibited.
6. Open fires and ground fires are prohibited.
7. Clotheslines may be a maximum of 6 feet long and must be temporary.
8. In-ground gardens are prohibited.
9. Please bag trash and debris and immediately deposit it in a dumpster.
10. One RV unit and limited parking for POV available per site.
11. The speed limit is 5 miles per hour.
12. Do not use sites for commercial ventures.
13. Quiet hours are from 2200 hours to 0600 hours.
14. Please use designated smoking areas.

Pets


All pets must have updated rabies and inoculations.

All pets must be registered and identified at check-in.

1. All pets must be kept on a leash when on base at all times. (with the exception of when the pet is in the RV)
2. Pets are not permitted inside base buildings or facilities.
3. It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that their pet does not disturb other campers & guests.
4. Pets are not permitted to foul any area on base. Each pet owner is responsible for cleaning up after their pet and discarding the debris in the dumpster.
5. The number of pets per site is limited to two. Farm or wild animals are not permitted.
6. Owners are financially liable for injuries and/or damages caused by their pets.
7. **Under no circumstances will a nuisance pet be tolerated. An occupant will be required to vacate the RV Park if the pet is deemed by the Marina & Outdoor Recreation staff as a "nuisance pet". Nuisance pets are ones that:**
 - Habitually or continuously bark, whine, howl, or cause other objectionable noise in such a manner or extent that it disturbs others.
 - Interferes, obstructs, or chases persons or vehicles.
 - Defecates on any site, sidewalks, playground, picnic area or any common area.
8. Portable Dog Runs are NOT allowed at the Mainside RV Park.

Mainside RV Park Map


The Mainside RV Park is located on-base next to the Marina

Driving Directions from NSA

Exit the Front gate and turn left. Go approximately 1.85 miles to the second traffic light. Turn left on Magnolia Beach Road. The campground gate is approximately 0.81 miles on the left at 5301 Magnolia Beach Road.


Southside RV Park Rules

1. RV's may not be vacated or left unoccupied for more than 96 hours.
2. RV units may not be subleased or released to other personnel; the individual renting the site must occupy the RV.
3. Tent camping is not allowed.
4. No external structures of any kind can be built/erected on a site.
5. Appliances, other than those designed in the RV, are prohibited.
6. Open fires/ground fires are prohibited.
7. Clotheslines may be a maximum of 6 feet long and must be temporary.
8. In-ground gardens are prohibited.
9. Trash/debris must be bagged and immediately deposited in dumpster.
10. One RV unit and one vehicle are permitted per site.
11. The speed limit in the campground is 5 miles per hour.
12. RV sites are not to be used for commercial ventures.
13. Quiet hours are from 2200 hours to 0600 hours.
14. Please use designated smoking areas.

Pets

1. All pets must be kept on a leash when on base at all times.
(with the exception of when the pet is in the RV)
2. Pets are not permitted inside base buildings or facilities.
3. It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that their pet does not disturb other guests.
4. Pets are not permitted to foul any area on base. Each pet owner is responsible for cleaning up after their pet & discarding debris in the dumpster.
5. Number of pets per site is limited to two.
Farm and wild animals are not permitted.
6. Owners are financially liable for injuries and/or damages caused by their pets.
7. **Under no circumstances will a nuisance pet be tolerated. An occupant will be required to vacate the RV Park if the pet is deemed by the Marina & Outdoor Recreation staff as a "nuisance pet". Nuisance pets are ones that:**
 - Habitually or continuously bark, whine, howl, or cause other objectionable noise in such a manner or extent that it disturbs others.
 - Interferes, obstructs, or chases persons or vehicles.
 - Defecates on any campsite, sidewalks, playground, picnic area or any common area.
8. Portable Dog Runs are approved for the Southside RV Park Only.
 - Portable Dog Run must be placed on the concrete site only.
 - Dog must not be left unattended at any time.
 - Under no circumstances may dogs defecate on the Concrete.
