



NSA Monterey, 7 March 2012, Press Release:

At the sites that are the home to the Naval Postgraduate School (NPS) and Fleet Numerical, Meteorological and Oceanographic Command (FNMOC), NSA Monterey will be participating in a Navy Exercise called Solid Curtain-Citadel Shield 2012 (SC-CS12). This Force Protection exercise will take place on all United States Navy installations from 19-24 March 2012. It will enhance the training and readiness of Naval security personnel to execute functional plans and operational capabilities. Exercise SC-CS12 is an annual exercise and not a response to any specific threat.

Local area residents may see increased military activity, and possible traffic or pedestrian congestion, associated with the exercise. Installation personnel, contractors, base visitors, and military retirees need to be flexible with their scheduling of meetings and appointments. During the exercise, changing security conditions could lead to an increase in traffic near and on the base. The installation will do everything possible to minimize off-base impact during this period.
