**NOTICE OF WORK**

Naval Base Point Loma Neighbors

Dear Residents:

Subj: REPLACEMENT OF FUEL STORAGE FACILITES - NAVAL BASE POINT LOMA

This notice is to inform Naval Base Point Loma neighboring residents that the demolition of the aboveground fuel storage tanks (ASTs) for the Defense Fuel Supply Point (DFSP) is underway. To this point, work has concentrated on the southern end of the project site farthest away from the fence line (please see attached map) with the demolition of Tank 63 and then Tank 61. The work was sequenced in this order to allow for noise and air quality testing to be performed prior to commencing work near the residential community. Testing indicates noise and air quality is within the levels of our Environmental Assessment. We are now ready to commence demolition of the tanks nearest the northern property line (62 and 58) beginning the week of September 8<sup>th</sup>. The work is expected to take approximately three weeks.

We have restricted our working hours from 7:15AM to 3:30PM each work day. These two tanks are over 80 feet away from the northern property line so no impact to local traffic or quality of life is expected; however, a potential byproduct of this effort is noise and dust, which will be closely monitored. During concrete demolition, water misting will be performed to eliminate dust emissions.

After the demolition of the two northern tanks, work will continue southward for the demolition of the remaining eight above ground fuel storage tanks. New ASTs will be constructed well over 200 feet from the northern property line. Further notices will be sent regarding this work.



