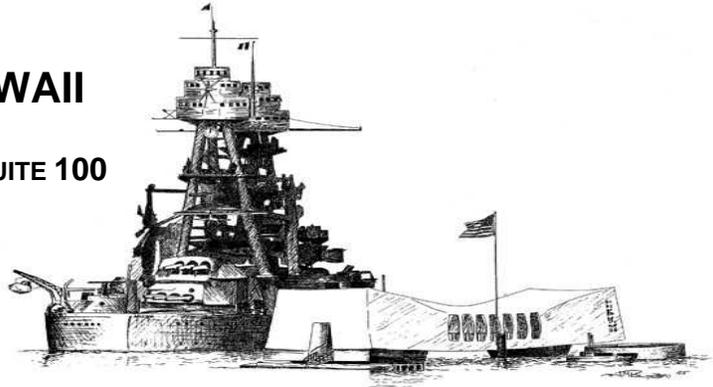

Tsunami Warning Cancelled *Pearl Harbor-based Navy ships to return*

PEARL HARBOR, HAWAII – Commander, Navy Region Hawaii and Naval Surface Group Middle Pacific has ordered the return of all Navy ships. The USS Crommelin (FFG37), USS Okane (DDG 77), USS Chafee (DDG-90), USS Chung-Hoon (DDG 93), departed Pearl Harbor this morning in response to the Tsunami Warning for the Hawaii Islands. No injuries or damage have been reported.

Access will be restored to previously evacuated areas. The Ford Island Bridge has reopened, and the Fleet and Family Support Center has stood down its family assistance center.

Pacific Missile Range Facility on Kauai is returning to normal operations, also reported no injuries or damage related to the Tsunami Warning.
