Update on human skeletal remains found near Pearl Harbor bike path

(PEARL HARBOR-HICKAM, HI) – The Naval Criminal Investigative Service determined there was no indication of criminal activity surrounding the discovery of human skeletal remains found near Blaisdell Park along the Pearl Harbor bike path today. Navy archaeologists were on scene and determined that the site is likely a historic era or traditional Hawaiian burial site.

Navy archaeologists will continue to assess the site and the State Historic Preservation Office has been contacted.

A fisherman reported discovering the remains at approximately 10:30 a.m. today near the shoreline in three to four inches of mud. Upon further assessment, two more skulls were discovered.

The Honolulu Police Department, which received the initial call, State DLNR and Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam Base Police assisted in the investigation.
