



Commander, Navy Installations Command Director Fleet and Family Readiness Mr. John Bradford Baker



After graduating in 1976 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Hotel and Restaurant Management from the University of Houston, Mr. Baker started working for U.S. Navy Quality of Life Programs as a management intern. Today, Mr. Baker's management oversight extends over 1,200 food service establishments, 120,000 "hotel rooms", 60,000 Family Houses, and 5,000 recreational facilities.

Mr. Baker was selected to the Senior Executive Service in August 2008.

As the Director, Fleet and Family Readiness at Commander, Navy Installations Command his areas of responsibility as Program Manager and Budget Submitting Officer (BSO) include: Morale, Welfare and Recreation (MWR), Child and Youth Programs, Fleet and Family Support Programs, Family and Bachelor Housing, Visitors Quarters, and Ashore Galley Operations located on 82 Installations and 285 combatant ships, with resources totaling 2.1 billion dollars and over 17,000 employees.

Prior to his current assignment Mr. Baker served in various locations as Management Analyst, Administrative Officer, Club Manager, MWR Director, Regional MWR Program Manager, Regional Community Services Director and Assistant Chief of Staff for Community Support Programs.

He has worked for the Chief of Naval Personnel, Commander Naval Forces Japan, Commander Fleet Activities Yokosuka, Naval Station Pearl Harbor Hawaii, Commander Naval Forces Philippines, Naval Station Subic Bay, Naval Amphibious Base Coronado, Naval Submarine Base Bangor, Commander Navy Regions Northwest and Southwest.

He earned the Secretary of the Navy's Best Consolidated Club Award, Secretary of the Navy Superior Service Award and Meritorious Service Award (twice) and also obtained his Masters in Business Administration. He completed a Senior Executive Fellowship at the John F. Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University, and received the prestigious International Military Community Executive Association Leadership award.
