

STARTING TIME RESERVATIONS

Monday-Thursday

Play on normal workdays is conducted on a first-come, first-served basis. It is suggested however, to call the Pro Shop to find out if the course is closed for a tournament or inclement weather.

Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Holidays

1. Active duty military stationed at Pax River or Webster Field may make a reservation 4 days in advance if 2 of the four-some are same. Please call: (301) 342-3597 after 0800.

- Monday for Friday tee time
- Tuesday for Saturday tee time
- Wednesday for Sunday tee time

2. Other active duty military and all other authorized patrons (other than contractors) may make automated reservations 3 days in advance. Eligible patrons must have a pin number which they can receive from the Pro Shop.

- Thursday for Sunday tee time

3. Contractors may make a reservation 2 days in advance. Please call (301) 342-3597.

Players must check in with the starter at least 5 minutes prior to their starting time. If not, the time will be issued to persons on a standby list.

HOURS OF OPERATION

The hours of operation for both the golf course and the clubhouse are published monthly and posted at the clubhouse. Current hours of operation may be obtained by calling the clubhouse at (301) 342-3597.

ELIGIBILITY

Use of the Cedar Point Golf Course is extended to the following personnel:

- Active duty military personnel and their family members.
- Retired members of the Armed Forces and their family members.
- Reserve personnel and their family members.
- Foreign military personnel on official visit duty status and their family members.
- DoD employees of Pax River and Webster Field complexes and family members.
- Retired DoD employees of Pax River and Webster Field complexes who possess a River's Edge Catering and Conference Center Membership.
- Members of the Local Chapter of the Navy League who hold River's Edge Catering and Conference Center Membership.
- Contractors of Pax River and Webster Field.
- 100% disabled veterans and their family members.
- Civilian guests must be sponsored by authorized personnel. Sponsors must play with their guests and are responsible for registering them at the Pro Shop and their conduct on the course.
- Others designated in the DoD instruction 1015-15 - MWR Programs.

DRESS CODE AND PERSONAL CONDUCT

Improper dress and conduct detract from the natural beauty, pleasant atmosphere and enjoyment of playing golf. The following rules of dress and conduct apply at the Cedar Point Golf Course and all practice areas.

DRESS CODE

1. Attire must properly cover the upper and lower torso.
2. All players and spectators must wear a shirt/blouse at all times.
3. UNACCEPTABLE dress for all players at all golf facility areas include the following:
 - a) Tee shirts whether printed or not
 - b) Shirts without a collar (men)
 - c) Running shorts, swim trunks, gym shorts, coaches' shorts, sweat pants or biker shorts

- d) Frayed/cut off/slashed shorts or slacks
- e) Shorts less than 16" in length
- f) Halter tops

4. Each person must wear shoes. Regulation golf shoes with non-metal spikes or flat soled shoes are the only approved footwear. Shoes with unusual soles (cowboy boots, sharp heels or all purpose athletic shoes) are not permitted.

For safety purposes and emergency notification, it is necessary for all golfers to register before playing.

PERSONAL CONDUCT - GOLF COURSE ETIQUETTE

1. All players must register in Pro Shop.
2. All players must replace divots, repair ball marks on greens and rake sand smoothly in bunkers.
3. Each player must have a set of clubs. Rental clubs are available at the Pro Shop.
4. Do not ride more than two people or carry more than two sets of clubs in a cart.
5. Do not place bags or pull carts in sand bunkers or on greens.
6. Keep carts on paths around all tees and greens.
7. Any group which has one clear hole in front of them, or fails to keep pace on the course, must invite groups following them to play through.
8. Shots are not made until the group in front is out of range, unless signaled to play through.
9. Care must be exercised when removing and replacing the flag from the hole to ensure against damage. Flags should not be thrown or dropped on the greens.
10. Do not drag spiked shoes on the putting greens. Leave clubs/cart between green and next tee while putting.
11. Upon completion of a hole, players should immediately leave the area of the green and head for the next tee.
12. "Mulligans" or practice shots should not be taken during normal play.
13. It is the responsibility of every player to keep the golf course, the area surrounding the clubhouse, practice areas and the parking lot clean by disposing of trash in appropriate receptacles.
14. Alcoholic beverages may not be brought to the Golf Course IAW liquor laws.

GENERAL RULES

Priority of play is given to foursomes. The Pro Shop or Starter may at their discretion, depending on the amount of play, allow threesomes, twosomes, or singles to play. Twosomes and singles are not allowed to play on weekends or holidays without the permission of the Pro Shop or Starter. Fivesomes are not allowed at any time.

Course marshals, starters, golf committee members and course management are responsible for enforcing the rules of play. They have the authority to request any player to leave the course for infractions of rules.

Participants are responsible for observing the rules of the facility. Violations of the rules could result in the suspension of Golf Course privileges for a period of time commensurate with the severity of the offense.

Children under the age of 10 playing golf must have prior approval by golf course management and must be accompanied by an adult. No children under 10 will be allowed on the Golf Course for any reason other than playing golf with an adult.

Pets are not permitted on the course, practice areas or in the clubhouse.

Driving range balls may be used in all practice areas. Driving range balls are not used on the golf course and are the property of the U.S. Government. Please repair all ball marks and rake all sand traps after practicing at the practice green.

All players start on the first tee unless authorized by the Pro Shop or Starter to start elsewhere.

TOURNAMENTS

All requests for golf outings or social outings at the course are accepted in writing by the Golf Course Manager.

Authorized tournaments and intramural play take priority over all other play. Dates and times are posted at the Golf Course in advance.
