**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Incumbent oversees swimming instruction program in accordance with the Red Cross curriculum. Performs work in and is responsible for the day to day swimming instruction program. Responsible for Water Safety Instructor in-service training. Ensures all paper work is completed and submitted to the Red Cross. Responsible for swim lesson registration and payment. Responsible for assisting instructors with curriculum and lesson plans. Provides class patron information to instructors. Monitors instructors during swim lessons. Performs rescue work and when necessary renders emergency care. Ensures all swimmers in the water are accounted for at all times.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

MUST have 2 years experience as a swimming instructor. Must have a current Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certificate and Lifeguard Certificate. Current CPR and First Aid are required. Must be at least 17 years old. Must be a mature individual who can exercise control over a group of people. Must be able to obtain access to base computer system, if applicable. Must be able to pass a background investigation. Must be available days, evenings and weekends.

**Note: All applicants must address the qualification requirements on your resume/application. If all required qualifications are not sited on your resume/application you will be disqualified**

Some positions have special requirements. In these cases selection is tentative pending satisfactory completion of these requirements. Applicants may be required to provide proof of education, etc. All selections are contingent upon the obtaining of satisfactory employment reference checks.
