Subj: NAVSUPPACT NAPLES SAILOR OF THE QUARTER/YEAR, JUNIOR SAILOR OF
THE QUARTER/YEAR, AND SAILOR OF THE YEAR (SOY) PROGRAM

1. Purpose. To promulgate eligibility and procedures for selection of the NAVSUPPACT Naples SOQ and SOY. This instruction is a complete revision and should be reviewed in its entirety.

2. Cancellation. NAVSUPPACT NAPLES INSTRUCTION 1700.9E

3. Discussion. This program recognizes the Sailor that best represents the large number of superior dedicated professionals in the command. The candidate is typified by sustained superior performance, proven leadership, a proven dedication to self-improvement, outstanding professionalism, and superior personal appearance. When reviewing candidates for selection, a special consideration should be given to those individuals who have excelled in increasingly demanding and challenging assignments. The selection of the candidates is based on nomination package and appearance before a formal board.

4. Eligibility

a. Senior Sailor of the Quarter (SSOQ): E-6 that has completed at least six months on board NAVSUPPACT Naples. Member must have a clear record with no non-judicial punishments or letters of indebtedness for the past six months. Past NJP and/or letters of indebtedness will be considered but will not exclude consideration. Additionally, nominees must have successfully passed the most recent PFA cycle and be within Navy height and weight standards.

b. Sailor of the Quarter (SOQ): As in 4a above, except paygrade E-5.

c. Junior Sailor of the Quarter (JSOQ): As in 4a above, except paygrade E-4.

d. Bluejacket of the Quarter (BJOQ): As in 4a above, except paygrades E-1 through E-3.

e. Senior Sailor of the Year (SSOY): E-6 that was nominated as SOQ during the previous calendar year, and other E-6's with at least 12 months on board NAVSUPPACT Naples.

f. Sailor of the Year (SOY): As in 4a above, except paygrade E-5.

g. Junior Sailor of the Year (JSOY): As in 4a above, except paygrade E-4.

h. Bluejacket of the Year (BJOY): As in 4a above, except paygrades E-1 through E-3.

5. Action. The following procedures will be utilized:

a. Nominations. Each department LCPO may submit one nomination from their respective department to the Command Master Chief.

(1) Submit all nominations using enclosure (1) no later than the last Tuesday of March, June, September, and December.

(2) Submit all nominations using enclosure (2), no later than the first Friday in January.

b. Boards

(1) The Command Master Chief chairs the SSOQ, SOQ, JSOQ, SSOY, SOY, and JSOY boards utilizing enclosure (2). All department LCPOs and Special Assistant LCPO's are voting members. SSOQ, SOQ, and JSOQ boards are held in April, July, October, and January. SSOY, SOY and JSOY boards will be held no later than 21 January.

(2) The President, First Class Petty Officer Association chairs the BJOQ and BJOY boards utilizing enclosure (2). All Department Leading Petty Officers are voting members. BJOQ board is held the first Tuesday of April, July, October, and January. BJOY board is held the second Tuesday in January.

c. Departments. The SOQ/SOY's department will prepare a nomination package for the area SOQ/SOY competition respectively per reference (a).

d. Commanding Officer. The Commanding Officer, NAVSUPPACT Naples, makes the final selection in all cases.
