SAZ and SBL are the only error codes the field will not be able to work on a normal basis. The other codes the field should be able to resolve 99.9% of the time (periodically there can be issues DFAS needs to resolve)

When interpreting error codes the (T) means the Transaction and (M) means the MMPA.

On the following page is an accuracy analysis that was done back in November 2007. It has some insight into resolving some of leave error codes.

Error: MHF – Cause is leave period overlaps reenlistment date (TG entry) of MMPA.

Solution: Process two SB03 transactions, one that ends the day before reenlistment date the other from reenlistment date forward. (Keep in mind that you will need two separate leave authorization numbers).

Error: MUX and MAL – Members account is in a SV status (separated)

Solution: Do not input send message to DFAS-CL to post leave.

Error: SBB and SDH – Leave authorization number has already been used on members MMPA.

Solution: Analyze MMPA ensure Leave Authorization number has not been used before. If trying to correct a leave period process SB05 transaction vice SB03.

Error: ZAJ – Cause mistyped members SSN.

Solution: Ensure transaction is verified before submitting.

Error: ZAN – Cause mistyped member's name.

Solution: Verify name on MMPA before submitting document.

Error: SBJ – Multiple causes

1.)34% of SBJ rejects are caused by the SB03 transaction being submitted twice on the same update by the same ADSN.

Solution: This is a Business practice issue at individual servicing ADSNs. DFAS is unable to determine why this is occurring.

2.) 33% of SBJ rejects are caused by a duplicate SB03 transaction being resubmitted on a different update (timeframe between original SB03 transaction and the duplicate SB03 transaction vary from 1 update later to 3 or 4 months later).

Solution: Analyze account before submitting transaction.

3.) 33% of SBJ rejects are caused because the period of leave on the SB03 transaction overlaps a posted leave period.

Solution: analysis account before submitting if correcting a posted leave period a SB05 transaction should be used.

Error: MAC – Caused because leave period is outside IAS (IAS is Current month plus 11 prior months)

Solution: Before submitting document ensure that leave dates are within IAS. If outside of IAS, send message to DFAS-CL to post leave.

Error: MAC – Leave period is outside IAS (IAS is Current month plus 11 prior months)

Solution: Before submitting document ensures that leave dates are within IAS. If outside of IAS, send message to DFAS-CL to post leave.

Error: MAL – Members account is in SV status (separated)

Solution: Do not input send message to DFAS-CL to post leave.

Error: SBH – Leave Authorization number on transaction does not match Leave Authorization number of leave period on MMPA that is being deleted.

Solution: Verify that the SB06 transaction matches a leave period on members MMPA (start date, stop date and leave authorization number).

Error: ZAJ – Mistyped members SSN.

Solution: Verify Transaction before submitting.

Error: ZAN – Mistyped member's name.

Solution: Verify name on MMPA before submitting document.

Solution: Verify that the SB06 transaction matches a leave period on members MMPA (start date, stop date and leave authorization number).
