ADDITIONAL SUPPORT TO THE SASEBO COMMUNITY

1. Emergency and off– duty hour calls. A chaplain may be reached by calling CFAS Security Quarter Deck: 252-3531. They will relay your request to the duty chaplain who will return your call.
2. Chaplains are available for individual and couple pastoral counseling. Appointments can be arranged by calling the chaplains' office. Walk-ins are always welcome.
3. Baptisms and dedications may be scheduled with our chaplains, governed by the requirements of their denominational faith group. You are requested to make an appointment with a chaplain so that preparation and scheduling may be done well in advance of a desired date.
4. Chaplains offer premarital counseling for service members and their prospective spouses that complements requirement mandate by CFAS. Premarital counseling is recommended and required by some denominational faith groups. Fleet and Family Services Center, NPPSC, and Base Legal Office can provide detailed information about administrative requirements for marriage in Japan.
5. The Community and Educational Center, Main Base or Hario Chapel facility usage for an event may be reserved by visiting the chaplain's office regarding availability. Completion of the space Reservation Request Form is necessary. Use of facilities will not be permitted if the activity conflicts with CFAS 1732.2D base regulation.
