



Teen Employment Program

In conjunction with the Commander Navy Installations Command (CNIC) and the Boys and Girls Club of America, the Teen Center is providing teen employment opportunities at various MWR, CYP and FFSC facilities.

Teens will:

- ~ Be hired to work at the Fleet & Family Support Center, Liaison Officer's Office (SLO) & various MWR Departments (Marketing, Administration Office, Auto Hobby & Wood Skills Center, Libraries, School-Age Care/Camp Adventure, Bowling Center, NOR Center, Aquatics, Fitness, School, and the Golf Course).
- ~ Get paid \$7.25 per hour
- ~ Work a maximum of 25 hours per week
- ~ Gain valuable work experience for their future

Important:

- ~ Teens must turn 15 years old by Fri, August 24 to be immediately eligible. If positions remain vacant following the 1st round of interviews, 14 year olds will then be considered.
- ~ Teens not selected for positions are welcome to contact the Teen Center Director for ways of improving themselves for future employment.




