Registration is required and may be made by calling (401) 841-2283. Active duty personnel, retirees, family members, reservists and DoD employees are welcome. All programs require a level of scheduling, staffing and purchasing of course material, so please register early.

September Programs & Workshops

3rd – FFSC Closed for Labor Day

5th – Smooth Move, 1 to 2 p.m.

Ease the stress and frustration associated with the relocation of military families by attending this workshop.

5th – Master Your Life, Master Your Anger, 8 a.m. to noon

This workshop discusses the emotion we call anger and looks at the constructive functions of anger in our daily living. Workshop goals include helping participants recognize the influence we have over our anger and its expression, and includes focus on skills and methods for managing our angry emotions safely and effectively.

6th – Starting Your Own Business, 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Participants will hear what it takes to open and run their own business. Advantages and disadvantages of running your own business will be addressed, as well as the steps needed for identifying the types of business to establish and financial resources to do so.

6th – Communication: For Better or For Worse, 1 to 3 p.m.

Our romantic relationships so often start out comfortable, satisfying and exciting. Along the way, we all face challenges, some anticipated and others surprise us. The freshness and the vitality can seem replaced by tedium and disappointment. Learn the importance of goal setting and how to examine life's priorities and develop a life plan.

18th – Are You Really Ready to Buy A Car?, 2:30 to 4 p.m.

You want to buy a new car. An image of your dream car hovers in your mind--it is shiny, colorful, and purrs like a kitten. But, standing between you and your dream car is the car dealer. How do you get the best car for a fair price? Find out how to gather your resources and be well informed.
