

## **NAVAL AIR STATION KINGSVILLE REPORTING ABOARD:**

Military families are encouraged to contact the Housing Welcome Center at (361) 516-6498 or DSN 876-6498 as soon as orders are received. The staff will help you locate suitable and affordable government or civilian housing in the local area. NAS Kingsville does not have on-base family government quarters.

Temporary family quarters can be arranged by contacting the Navy Gateway Inns & Suites Office at (361) 516-6321 or DSN 876-6321. Unaccompanied Housing check-in is available from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily. After hours please call the duty number at (361) 438-6994.

## **SPONSOR ASSISTANCE**

Newcomers are also encouraged to contact the NAS Corpus Christi Personal Property Office as soon as possible after receiving orders to arrange shipment of household goods. Once shipment dates are known, contact the Personal Property Office to arrange storage or delivery of household goods.

Preplanning is essential for newcomers moving to the Kingsville area. All new military personnel should hear from a gaining-command sponsor shortly after receiving orders. If not, contact your gaining command and ask for your sponsor's name and phone number. Your gaining command should also provide you with a mailing address where letters can be forwarded until a permanent address can be established.

Inform your sponsor of your planned arrival times so that reservations may be made for berthing in advance. If you do not have a sponsor assigned, you should contact your command Admin Office and request one be assigned to you to help with your check in process. The NAS Kingsville command Admin Office can be reached by calling (361) 516-6288 or 516-6476 during normal work hours Monday through Friday. After hours, call (361) 774-5749.

## **ARRIVAL**

NAS Kingsville is located approximately 40 miles south of Corpus Christi — the eighth largest city in Texas — just one mile from Highway 77 and the city of Kingsville. The exit to the base is clearly marked at Highway 77 and FM 425.

Taxi service is available from Corpus Christi International Airport (approximately \$99). A Greyhound bus also runs between Corpus Christi and downtown Kingsville (approximately \$18). However, people arriving at the airport may want to contact their sponsor ahead of time for helpful information about available transportation.

## **CHECK-IN**

Newcomers are encouraged to check in before 4 p.m. at the prospective command headquarters building. Enlisted personnel reporting to the NAS Kingsville command should report to Bldg. 2740, located on McCain Street. When arriving after duty hours, contact the NAS Kingsville Command Duty Officer (CDO) by calling (361) 438-6938.

If you are arriving by POV, you will need to show the gate guard your military ID and orders upon entering the base. Be sure to have your driver's license, a copy of current vehicle insurance and current vehicle registration papers.

Newcomers should report to their duty station Administrative Department the first work day after arrival where they will be provided with an in-processing checklist. Note: No Personnel Support Activity is available at NAS Kingsville. This service is provided at NAS Corpus Christi.
