1. Purpose. To conduct earthquake safety drill and provide earthquake preparedness information onboard U.S. Naval Support Activity (NAVSUPPACT), Naples, Italy.
2. Background. The Great Southern Italy Shakeout is one of a number of Shakeout events worldwide that will simultaneously occur on 18 October 2012.
3. Schedule. See enclosure (1).
4. Locations. See enclosure (1).
5. Attire. Uniform of the Day for military personnel and appropriate attire for civilians.
6. Procedures. Preparation and execution of the Great Southern Italy Shakeout are described in enclosures (1) and (2).
7. Action. Implement simulated earthquake drill followed by earthquake preparedness information session.

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SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Thursday, 18 October 2012 NAVSUPPACT Capodichino

- 0700 - 1000 Emergency Management (EM) personnel will coordinate with respective NAVSUPPACT entities which will include Safety, Fire, Environmental, Public Works (PW), Chief's Mess, Navy Exchange (NEX), Red Cross, Fleet Family Support Center (FFSC), Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR), Medical EMO, Community Bank, and Banco di Napoli to prepare the Capodichino Piazza for the 1020 information session
- 1018 Shakeout drill will commence. A simulated Earthquake will be broadcasted over the Public Alerting System (PAS) loudspeakers and Big Voice. This will be accompanied by Computer Desktop Notification System (CDNS) voice, text and desktop messaging. Participating personnel will be instructed to execute "Duck, Cover, and Hold On" earthquake survival technique
- 1019 After the simulated earthquake is over, all participating personnel will be asked to muster at the Piazza
- 1020 - 1040 Once everyone is gathered in the Capodichino Piazza, EM will give a presentation on earthquake preparedness
- 1050 - 1230 Participants will be encouraged to visit various booths set up for the previously mentioned NSA entities to receive products and information on earthquake preparedness
- 1230 Clean-up/End of Event

Thursday, 18 October 2012 NAVSUPPACT Support Site

- 0700 - 1000 EM personnel will set up booths with respective NAVSUPPACT entities which will include Safety, Fire, NEX, Red Cross, Environmental, PW, FFSC, Medical EMO, and MWR to prepare the lawn in front of the Navy Lodge for the 1020 information session

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- 1018 Shakeout drill will commence. A simulated earthquake will be broadcasted over the PAS loudspeakers and Big Voice. This will be accompanied by CDNS voice, text and desktop messaging. Participating personnel will be instructed to execute "Duck, Cover, and Hold on" earthquake survival technique
- 1019 After the simulated earthquake is over all participating personnel will be asked to muster at the lawn in front of the Navy Lodge
- 1020 - 1230 Participants will be encouraged to visit various booths set up by the various base entities to receive products and information on earthquake preparedness
- 1230 Clean-up/End of Event
